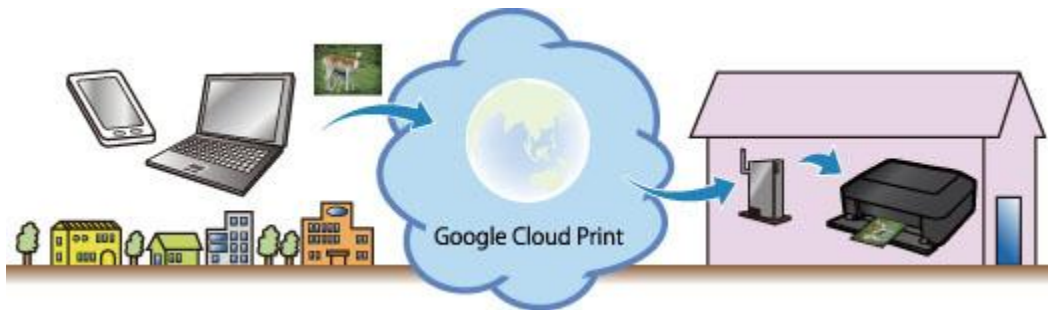




How to Use Google Cloud Print

How to Use Google Cloud Print

The machine is compatible with Google Cloud Print™ (Google Cloud Print is a service provided by Google Inc.).
By using Google Cloud Print, you can print from anywhere with applications or services supporting Google Cloud Print



Checking Your Environment

First check your printer environment.

- Printer software (firmware) version

If the printer firmware version is Version 3.000 or later, it supports Google Cloud Print. To check the firmware version running on your printer, see "[Check if the Firmware Update is necessary.](#)"

If your Canon printer does not support Google Cloud Print, you must use the Printer Update Utility and update the printer firmware. For instructions about the update procedure, refer to "[Update Procedure.](#)"

How to Use Google Cloud Print

The flow from registering the machine to using Google Cloud Print is described below.

- When registering this machine or when using Google Cloud Print to print data, this machine must be connected to a LAN and the LAN environment must be connected to the Internet. The user is responsible for paying all Internet connection fees.

This function is available only when **IPv4** is selected for **TCP/IP settings** on **Other settings** from LAN settings.

For instructions about displaying **Other settings** on the operation panel, refer to the on-screen manual that comes with the printer.
