




Setting Up The Receive Mode



Receiving A Fax

To receive a fax when you are home you will:

- Pick up the handset on the phone connected to the MX360 or MX410.
- Listen for fax tones.
- When the tones stop hang up the handset.
- The MX360 or MX410 will receive the fax document.

To receive a fax while you are away:

- The answering machine will answer the call.
- If fax tones are heard by the MX360 or MX410 it will take over the call and receive the fax document.

IMPORTANT: In order to receive a fax, you must either pick up the handset on a phone that is connected to the MX360 or MX410 or let your answering machine answer the call.
