



CANON PRINTERS WITH AMAZON ALEXA COMPATIBILITY

You can have your Amazon Alexa communicate directly with your Canon Printer. By asking Alexa, you can have your Canon printer print countless things like lists, templates and coloring pages, to even check your ink levels and read printer notifications. Alexa lives in the cloud, so it's always getting smarter, adding new capabilities that are delivered to your device automatically. Using Alexa with your Canon Printer is simple and hands-free – just ask, and Alexa will respond instantly.

To use Amazon Alexa with their compatible Canon printer, users will need the Amazon Alexa app installed on their smartphone and a 'skill' enabled.

To use the skill, users must speak :

1. The wake word: **"Alexa"** and
2. The invocation name: **"Canon Printer"** and
3. Then the skill.

Examples:

"Alexa, ask Canon Printer to print coloring pages for children."
"Alexa, ask Canon Printer to check ink status."

- Checklist Paper
- Staff Paper

Check Printer Status:

- Ink Level(s) Status
- Printer Notifications & Error Messages
